Southern California Edison (SCE) and The Climate Registry are pleased to announce the Cool Planet Project's Cool Planet Awards, recognizing SCE business customers for their environmental leadership in energy and carbon management.

Cool Planet Award recipients will be recognized by their industry sector and will be honored with a plaque made from recycled glass and a media relations campaign highlighting their leadership.

Each industry sector* will recognize awards in two categories (based on size):
