States and provinces appoint new Executive Director of The Climate Registry

(October 17, 2011 – Los Angeles, CA) The Board of Directors of The Climate Registry – comprising 40 US states, 13 Canadian provinces and territories, six Mexican states, and four native sovereign nations - today announced the appointment of David Rosenheim to the position of Executive Director. He replaces Denise Sheehan, who is moving on to another opportunity.

Mr. Rosenheim is a proven senior executive with experience as Chief Operating Officer, Chief Executive Officer and Director on four corporate Boards. He currently runs U.S. business development for Offsetters, a leading carbon management organization, and also serves as co-director of the Northern California chapter of Environmental Entrepreneurs. He has an MBA from Oxford University, and has extensive experience across the range of key business functions.
