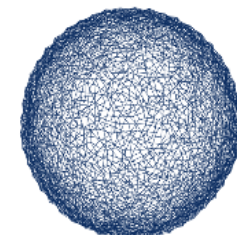
## Nineteen Organizations Are Now Climate Registered!
